Carolyn S. Langdon, 100, died peacefully, Thursday, December 13, 2012 at the Avery Heights Nursing Home in Hartford, CT. She was preceded in death by her late husband, Howard G. She also compiled her own and her husband's family genealogical histories. For 21 years she was Co-Chairperson of the Historical Society of Glastonbury's Antique Booth at their annual fund raising show. In addition she was а member of the 1st Congregational Church in Wethersfield, and later the 1st Congregational Church of Glastonbury. She is survived by her son, Howard G. Langdon, Jr. and his wife Carol of Williamsburg, Virginia, two grandsons, Howard G. Langdon, III (Chip) of Centerville, Ohio, and David S. Langdon of Alexandria, Virginia and three great grandchildren. Burial will be at a private ceremony in Pittsfield, Mass.
